David Waldemar Besuden, 96, passed away peacefully at home on August 30, 2013 surrounded by family. David, a proud 4th generation Cincinnati was also an 81 year summer resident of Manitoulin Island, Ontario, Canada where he was happiest, especially on his beloved Lake Manitou.

Since 1981 he has been a resident of Marco Island, FL.

David was predeceased by the wife he adored for 66 years, Charlene; and his dear brother, George.

He is survived by four devoted children and their spouses, Sue Nemenz (Ken) of Indian Hill, OH and Naples, FL, Dianne Hallberg of Highland Beach, FL, Debbie Geehring (Jim) of Wyoming, OH, and David Besuden (Michelle) of Loveland, OH. Recently, West Marine has cancelled our membership in Port Supply, negating our ability to purchase items at discounted prices.

As a result, we have negotiated an agreement with Boat Owner's Warehouse (BOW) in Fort Lauderdale to enable MBYC members to purchase at a discounted price (with the blessing of our Commodore, Marcia Orsolini). BOW prices, in general, are less expensive than West Marine's prices, plus we get an additional discount of approximately 10% (depending on the item). If the item is in stock, they will ship to us by USPS, or UPS, and since shipment is Florida to Florida, we should receive items overnight, with no charge for ground shipments.

We can order on-line, by phone, or in person. Identify yourself as a member of the Marco Bay Yacht Club and give them our member number, which is 02-6424214. They will corroborate who you are by referring to an abbreviated club roster. Please ask for a BOW catalog to be included with any item you order.
