

Sand bars in Naples intercoastal waters are constantly shifting. Be especially careful near markers 27 and 28 on the way to Marco Island. There were two accidents with injuries in that location in January, both with experienced captains traveling in the channel. Another safety tip: When your boat is on-plane, encourage all passengers to be comfortably seated and close cabin doors. Safe boating everyone!


