MBYC 2016-2017 CRUISING SEASON WELL INTO PLANNING STAGE

Now that our last MBYC cruising season has come to an end, your cruise team is already hard at work planning new adventures for next season. While dates and marinas have not all been finalized, a list of the proposed cruises and dates for next season are as follows:

October 17 - 21 to Legacy Marina October 21 – 25 to Pink Shell Marina

November 11 - 15 to Faro Blanco in Marathon November 15 - 20 to The Galleon in Key West

January 16 - 20 to South Seas Marina January 20 – 24 to Boca Grande Marina

February 15 - 17 to Palm Island Marina
