In most cases, hotel accommodations, at the marina or nearby, are available for anyone wishing to come by either small boat or by car or just not wanting to overnight on their boat.


While most cruises fill up quickly, there are normally cancellations and, up to now, we have always been able to accommodate all who wish to join in.
