#### **Key West Cruise**

We were thrilled to have the Hoovers on their first MBYC cruise.

Our cruise was originally scheduled to depart directly to The Galleon in Key West but the group made the decision to make Faro Blanco a preliminary stop so we could get a better handle on the weather forecast for our return from Key West because several in the group had Thanksgiving plans and had to be back.

The cruise to Faro Blanco had us in gusty winds from the Northeast so once we passed Cape Romano we headed toward shore for a reasonably good ride to Marathon. However, once we docked at Faro Blanco the north winds came right into the channel and really rocked the boats, especially My Turn, for 2 days and nights.

On Wednesday everyone but Therapy headed down Hawks Channel to The Galleon in Key West. Unfortunately Therapy III had suffered a stabilizer breakdown and had to remain docked in Faro Blanco waiting for parts. Not to be left behind, the Browns called up an Uber for a ride to Key West and stayed near the marina at the new Marker Resort Hotel.

We had a wonderful time in Key West hitting all of our favorite dining places including Pepe's. Hard Rock Cafe, A&B Lobster House, Two Friends and of course LaTeDa. After dinner at LaTeDa, we all attended the Cabaret Show featuring Randy Roberts. As happened before, Mike Brown got the aisle seat and became Randy's target throughout his, or is it her, entire performance.

Every sailboat in the bay broke free from the mooring and was either piled on the rock jetty, on the beach at Sunset Key: or had sunk.

On Friday, the 17th the Browns Ubered back to Marathon to their repaired boat and on Saturday the four boats in Key West headed back to Marco via Hawks Channel, Moser Channel and along the shoreline to Marco.\*\*\*\*The entire cruise was great fun and we hope more of our extended cruise boaters will join us on more of our cruises this season.
