On November 10th 6 MBYC boats headed out to Faro Blanco Marina on Marathon for a previsit ahead of the planned cruise to The Galleon on Key West. Cookin', Nauti Buoy, My Cherie, Karine, Swell Times III and No Name (Eric Zimmerman) decided the sea conditions looked much better on the 10th than the 12th so we grabbed 6 slips at Faro Blanco and left 2 days early in nearly flat seas.

Faro Blanco is always a fun destination with a nice new marina, wonderful staff, a great restaurant and, most importantly, a wonderful card playing room for the canasta ladies.

The Barnes had guests, Mike and Linda, aboard so we had a nice group of 13 people (Kris Zimmerman was tied up with golf) who enjoyed fun and games together as well as a bit of shopping at West Marine.
