
Our Chaplin Alan Sandlin delivered an inspiring grace and dinner was served.

## Marathon & Key West 2019 Cruise Trip Report

On Thursday, November 14th, six boats including Cookin' (Brent & Susan Cook), Nauti Buoy (Dave & Mary Ellen Mount), Karine (Bob & Sandy LaMontagne along with Karen & Bri), My Cherie (Jerry & Cherie Hoover), Wild Hawk (Bruce & Debbie Boyer along with Bill & Kim Hillyer) and Divergent (Bill Schroeder) all arrived at Faro Blanco Marina on Marathon.

The ride south was a bit bumpy with 3'-4' seas but with Karine in the lead we had a reasonably good ride for the five boats that left Marco that morning. Wild Hawk left a bit later and with their speed arrived first.

On our arrival day we were joined by Mike and Cindy Brown who came by car and on Friday, also coming by Land Yacht, were John & Dianne Kernan, Claudette & Barry Gelfand, Bob & Jo Herndon and Bob Boland and Lyn Bedell. Arriving on Saturday were Al & Ginny Rapp. With our boaters, and Land Yachters, we had a total of 28 people.

There was no one single group dinner but we did sample The Butterfly Café at Tranquility Bay Resort, Lazy Days, The Lighthouse Grille, Keys Fisheries and Florida Steak & Lobster House so there was no shortage of fun places to eat.

In nearly flat seas the Key West boaters arrived at The Galleon shortly after noon on Monday. We were joined in Key West by the Browns and Rapps who both said there were no waves on US-1.

## **November Madness**




