

MBYC Jetski Special Interest Group (JSIG)



You don't hear about all of the JSIG events that we hold because most outings are determined on very short notice, and we are now hitting our limit of allowable skis in an event about 50% of the time. The maximum participation is 8 jetskis for safety reasons and we have 2 groups - the Turtle group (slower and can include Craig Cats and a beach picnic) and the Rabbit Group (faster with only a beach stop to stretch).

I was asked recently if we have a group between the Turtles and the Rabbits and started to think about it. I can now say that - yes we have a 3rd group, but I call them the Greyhounds.
